



#### ✓ THROW IN I.A.:

paper packaging, cardboard egg boxes, newspapers, magazines, printed paper, notebooks and books without covers.

DON'T THROW IN I.A.: juice and milk cartons, dirty paper towels, nappies and hygiene articles, laminated paper, dirty paper/paperboard (e.g. dishes)

## ✓ THROW IN I.A.:

bottles and jars, cosmetic glass packaging.

**DON'T THROW IN I.A.:** bulbs, mugs, crockery, wine glasses, mirrors, broken glass.

#### **✓ THROW IN:**

unsorted waste, such as nappies and hygiene products, pottery, crockery, mirrors, dirty paper, receipts, polystyrene foam, bones and meat waste, ash and soil, animal droppings.

**REMEMBER:** THE LESS MIXED WASTE, THE LESS WASTED RAW MATERIALS.

plastic packaging, milk and juice cartons, plastic bags and carrier bags, bottle caps, cans and tins, aluminium foil.

**DON'T THROW IN I.A.:** medicine packaging, appliances, electronics, used batteries, paint and adhesive containers, polystyrene foam.

## ✓ THROW IN I.A.:

peelings and waste of fruit and vegetables, leftovers, egg shells, coffee and tea grounds, leaves, flowers, grass, shredded branches

DON'T THROW IN I.A.: bones and dead animals, animal droppings, impregnated wood, biodegradable bags, ash and soil.
